He's going to brush his teeth and then he's going to have a bath but he isn't going to have a bath in the bathroom, he's going to have a bath in the sea! Why isn't Timmy doing anything today? Well, he isn't doing anything today because yesterday was the last day of school and Timmy is on holidays at the beach!

FUTURO DE INTENCIÓN

`GOING TO´ (Ir a...)

Utilizamos GOING TO para formar lo que se conoce como Futuro de Intención. Su estructura es muy sencilla;

Se forma con el Verbo TO BE + going to + Verbo Principal

Example

Vamos a realizar una conjugación completa con el verbo **play** en AFIRMATIVO y NEGATIVO.

AFIRMATIVO

- I am going to play → Yo voy a jugar
- You are going to play → Tú vas a jugar
- He is going to play → Él va a jugar
- She is going to play → Ella va a jugar
- It is going to play → Esto va a jugar
- We are going to play → Nosotros vamos a jugar
- You are going to play → Vosotros vais a jugar
- They are going to play → Ellos van a jugar

NEGATIVO

- I am not going to play → Yo no voy a jugar
- You aren't going to play → Tú no vas a jugar
- He isn't going to play → Él no va a jugar
- She isn't going to play → Ella no va a jugar
- It isn't going to play → Esto no va a jugar
- We aren't going to play → Nosotros no vamos a jugar
- You aren't going to play → Vosotros no vais a jugar
- They aren't going to play → Ellos no van a jugar

El ejemplo que he puesto sirve para cualquier otro verbo: eat, jump, watch, go...
